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Build Stuff Workshops



We focus on craft, artistic miniature or other creations that involve manual construction. Assistance is provided to scope, plan, complete and effectively communicate individual projects.

Over the course of several months each participant creates a detailed design, project budget, and production schedule. In the context of their projects, we explore and practice different ways to communicate: writing, photographs, video – all of which will serve students in the workplace.



Filmmaking Workshops

Storytelling, animation and editing are just a few of the skills learned in the Filmmaking Workshops. All these activities engage executive functioning and increase social interaction. Each participant creates a storyboard, a production schedule and a short film.

Each member chooses his/her own project, subject matter and filmmaking style. Group members are encouraged to share their talents and skills to help each other succeed.



Fabric/Fine Art Workshops

The Fabric and Fine Arts Workshops offer support for a wide variety of creative projects. We have helped students create cosplay costumes to wear to anime conventions as well as create clay figures, polymer beads, and stained glass.



College Support Group

The College Support Group meets weekly to provide academic and social support to college students.

In each session, students receive guidance and support with completing homework assignments and studying for exams. Development of time management, organizational, and study skills are integral to the program. There is follow-up throughout the week via email, text and phone messages.

We encourage peer mentoring: students help each other navigate the college social and academic environment.

Additional individual tutoring is available in several subject areas including Math, Science, Computer Programming, History, and English.
